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#### Did you know !

Large formats have a widely observed track record of maturing much slower than halves or full size bottles. Magnums and above have a slightly lower ratio of head space air to wine volume potentially slowing down the maturation process. Provided that the said wines have been kept in ideal conditions, it is therefore advisable to open a magnum rather than two full size bottles. Matured wines if well preserved, usually offer much more complexity

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Clos des Goisses' 5.50 ha of vines have a South exposure and therefore yield wines that are often ultra ripe , thus needing to keep their natural acidity by blocking malo-lactic fermentations. Although Pinot Noir dominated, the 30 % Chardonnay adds finesse to it . The wine are barrel fermented and require time to age gracefully to reward you with what I reckon is one of the most complex Champagne produced.
